

Character Input

You can input characters when making the communication settings (mail address, title, message, etc.) as explained below.

■ Inputting

● Select the item and press the button to display the character input screen.



- ② Select the desired character by using the ⑥ · ⑦ · ⑥ · ⑥ buttons and press the FUNCTION button.
- 3 Press the ENTER button to exit the character input screen.



■ Deleting

In step ② above use the $\textcircled{\bullet} \cdot \textcircled{\bullet} \cdot \textcircled{\bullet} \cdot \textcircled{\bullet}$ buttons to move the cursor on the right position of the character to be deleted and press the $\textcircled{\text{m}}$ button.

Note • Details of communication setting items are given on page 22 "Setting Items for Communications".

Troubleshooting

In the case of misoperation or when processing cannot be performed due to some problem, an error message will be displayed. This section explains the causes of problems and how to remedy them.



• Communication may be terminated due to the situation of the radio frequency, usage environment, etc. Check that the camera is located under optimal condition.






