




The inside of the battery/card and terminal covers are not waterproof In locations where the camera is exposed to water or dirt such as underwater, at the beach, in a kitchen, etc., make sure that the battery/card and terminal cover lock levers are firmly locked so that they won't open unexpectedly. Do not open the covers in such locations.

• When removing the battery or card, avoid surroundings where the camera may be exposed to water or dirt, and make sure the camera, battery, card, and your hands are completely dry.

# **Turning the Camera On**

## Press the nower switch.

The camera turns on and is ready to take still pictures. Press the power switch again to turn the camera off.



## • Make the Initial Settings.

The [Language/言語] screen appears when the camera is turned on for the first time. Select the desired language and then set the date and time.



- 9 Press the four-way controller ( ▶ ) to select [mm/dd/yy], then use the four-way controller (▲▼) to choose the date format

- 10 Press the four-way controller ( > ) to select [24h], then use the four-way controller ( A V ) to select [24h] (24-hour display) or [12h] (12-hour display).
- Press the four-way controller ( > ), then press the four-way controller (▼) to move the frame to [Date].
- 12 Press the four-way controller ( ) to select [01] (month), [01] (day) or [2012] (year), then use the four-way controller (▲▼) to set the current date.
- Press the four-way controller (►), then press the four-way controller ( ▼ ) to move the frame to [Time].
- 14) Set the time in the same manner as in 12.
- 15 Press the four-way controller (▼) to select [Settings complete] and press the **OK** button.



## Formatting an SD Memory Card



# **3** Taking Pictures

Aim the camera at the subject, then press the shutter release button. The flash discharges automatically depending on the brightness.

- 1 Frame the subject using the focus frame on the display.
- Press the W/T button to change the captured area.



3 Press the shutter release button halfway.

The focus frame on the display turns green if the subject is in focus.


Press the shutter release button fully.

The picture is taken.



## Selecting the Flash Mode

Each time you press the four-way controller ( ◀ ), the flash mode switches between the following modes.

Each time you press the four-way controller (  $\blacktriangle$  ), the drive mode switches between the following modes.



## ●The monitor display in 4:3 aspect ratio

When [Recorded Pixels] is set to \$\frac{16M}{7M}/\frac{5M}{3M}/\frac{1024}{640}\$ in [
Rec. Mode], the aspect ratio of the image is 4:3 and the monitor display for shooting and playback mode is as shown below.

## Playing Back Images

1 Press the button after shooting.

The image appears on the display.



#### Memo

- To play back the previous or next image, press the four-way controller ( ◀ ▶ ).
- Pressing button during playback displays 6 thumbnail images.
   Pressing again in 6-image display switches to 12-image display.
   Pressing yet again switches to folder or calendar display.

## Deleting Images

Deleting a Single Image

You can delete a single image currently displayed on the display.

1 Play back the image you want to delete.

2 Press the 🗑 button.

The confirmation screen appears.

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4 Press the OK button.

#### (Memo)

- You can delete several images selected from the 6- or 12-image display. For details, refer to the Operating Manual (p.136).
- You can delete all images at once. For details, refer to the Operating Manual (p.137).
- You can protect stored images from being accidentally deleted.

## Selecting a Playback Mode

You can choose the playback function you want to use with the Playback Mode Palette.

Press the four-way controller ( ) while an image is displayed in playback mode.



Use the four-way controller (▲▼◀▶) to choose a playback mode, then press the OK button.
